His most recent books include the international bestsellers, *The Green New Deal* (2019), *The Zero Marginal Cost Society* (2014), *The Third Industrial Revolution* (2011), *The Empathic Civilization* (2010), *The European Dream* (2004), *The Hydrogen Economy* (2002), *The Age of Access* (2000), *The Biotech Century* (1998), and *The End of Work* (1995).

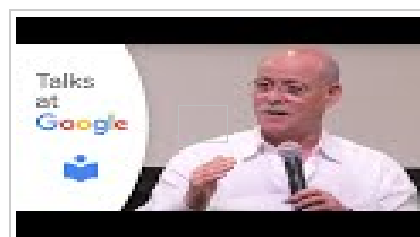
