Andy's endeavors as an entrepreneur began at an early age; he co-created Fundación Iniciativa to promote leadership among Latin American youth when he was just 18.

Andy successfully built his business and created the leading business to business e-commerce platform in Latin America. He was chosen as "Young Global Leader 2008" by the World Economic Forum.
