One of the most innovative projects that Hayley has headed up is the *LeasePlan Women's Arctic Challenge* in which she co-led a team of women on a traverse of Baffin Island, trekking and camping for 11 days at minus 40 degrees C. Hayley worked with LeasePlan to develop this unique platform to communicate the gender balance issue and challenge unconscious bias within their company and the wider car industry - the project also involved 150 schools in an education program.
